Prizes: One prize of Euro 1,500 will be awarded to the best conference papers written by young scientists in Macroeconometrics or Financial Econometrics (Carlo Giannini Prize, offered by *SIIE*). One prize of Euro 2,500 will be awarded to the best conference papers written by young scientists in Theoretical or Applied Microeconometrics (Labour Prize, offered by *LABOUR: Review of Labour Economics and Industrial Relations*). For eligibility to both prizes, all authors of a paper must be no more than 4 years past the PhD defense.
