Description

The **Department of** Environmental Sciences, Informatics and Statistics at **Università Ca' Foscari Venezia** invites applications for a post-doc fellowship in: Area 13/D1-SSD: SECS-S/01 *Statistic, Thematic Area:* Modelling and Analysis of Big Data

The research will be carried out in English.

The fellowship is intended to provide the successful candidate with the opportunity to pursue his/her own research while benefiting from the range of expertise at Università Ca' Foscari Venezia.

Who can apply

Prospective candidates are expected to hold a doctoral degree in **Statistics**, **Mathematics**, **Computer Science and Economics** or related disciplines.

Ca' Foscari encourages applications from researchers with positive evaluation in all the criteria in individual proposals such as Marie Skłodowska Curie/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar.

Researchers having successfully completed Marie Skłodowska Curie/ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) or similar funded projects are warmly encouraged to apply.

Duration of contract: 24 months - expected starting date: May-June 2015

Stipend: The research fellowship amounts to **23367.00** Euros per year, including taxes and social charges.

Research allowance:

The successful candidate will have at his/her disposal a research allowance, equal to **1168,35** Euros, aimed at covering actual research costs.

Deadline for submission of applications: May 14, 2015.

How to apply:

Candidates should submit:

- 1. The application form , duly dated and signed (<u>link</u>);
- 2. A CV in European format, duly dated and signed (<u>link</u>);
- 3. A copy of a valid identity document (either Identity Card or Passport);
- 4. (If available) Evaluation Summary Reports of Marie Skłodowska Curie/ ERC Starting Grants/FIRB (Italian Fund for basic research investments)/SIR (Scientific Young Independence Research) individual proposals having passed all the evaluation thresholds;
- 5. (If available) Details of Marie Skłodowska Curie, ERC Starting Grants, FIRB (Italian



Fund for basic research investments)/ SIR Scientific Young Independence Research funded projects;

- 6. A research proposal either in English (<u>link</u>);
- All documents, qualifications and publications relevant for the selection procedure (please, see the notice - <u>link</u>);

How to submit your application

Applications should be submitted by the deadline choosing among the following procedures (1a, 1b, 1c,1d):

Evaluation

Up to 100 points, specifically:

- For qualifications, publications and possible tests, from 0 to 50;
- For research proposal, from 0 to 30;
- For interview, from 0 to 20.

Selection procedure

Eligible candidates will be invited for an interview on **May 18th 2015 at 14,30 (Italian Time)** at Department of Environmental Sciences, Informatics and Statistics, Scientific Campus of the University Ca' Foscari of Venice, Building ALFA- 3° floor Office n.3 - Via Torino 155 - 30172 Mestre (Venice) Italy.

The final shortlist will be avalaible on May 18th 2015.

The interview aims to assess the candidates' skills and expertise on the following subjects:

Modeling and Analysis of Big Data

Candidates living farther than 200 Kms from Venice may ask to hold a video interview.
