The Master's program in Economics (MEI) is aimed at preparing economists for professional work in business or research, with particular regard to financial and public institutions and the international environment. It is also designed to provide one year of intensive training to students interested in joining a Doctoral program in Italy or abroad.

Master in Economics

The program is divided in two semesters:

- *First semester:*
16/09/2002 - 20/12/2002
- *Second semester:*
10/02/2003 - 09/05/2003

At the end of the second semester students are expected to write a report based on either an internship or a research project

Admission

Candidates must be either:

- Holders of an undergraduate degree (Laurea or equivalent)
- Students in their final undergraduate year, who will obtain their degree (Laurea or equivalent) by the end of July 2002.

Application

Applications must enclose the following documentation (in English or Italian):

- Application form
- Curriculum Vitae
- A statement of research or professional purposes
- Transcript of the undergraduate record
- General Record Examination (General Part), compulsory for non-Italian students and strongly recommended for Italian ones.
- TOEFL or similar certificate of proficiency in English
- Two letters of recommendation
